

Short Term Public Notice of Network Change Under Rule 51.333(a) Wholesale Hosted IP Communications (HIPC)

July 12, 2005

Type of Change:

Wholesale Hosted IP Communications (HIPC) is a hosted telephony service that functions on industry-standard protocols and provides routing information, call signaling, protocol conversion, and other functions to enable full on-net calling to and from any IP telephony user and off-net calling to the Public Switched Telephone Network. Users will receive IP telephony based on the signaling Session Initiation Protocol (SIP) and media exchange that is based on the Real-time Transport Protocol (RTP). These protocols were previously disclosed in Verizon's Hosted VoIP Service Notice of Network Change dated April 5, 2005.

The signaling protocol disclosed for this service is the Client Application Protocol (CAP), an XML-based BroadSoft application protocol that exchanges messages as XML documents. This protocol provides a standard messaging interface between external applications and BroadWorks, enabling an open, non-proprietary mechanism for any third-party application to perform call control actions via BroadWorks.

The following technical reference and subsequent versions shall apply as an interface requirement between the Verizon network and third-party applications providers.
