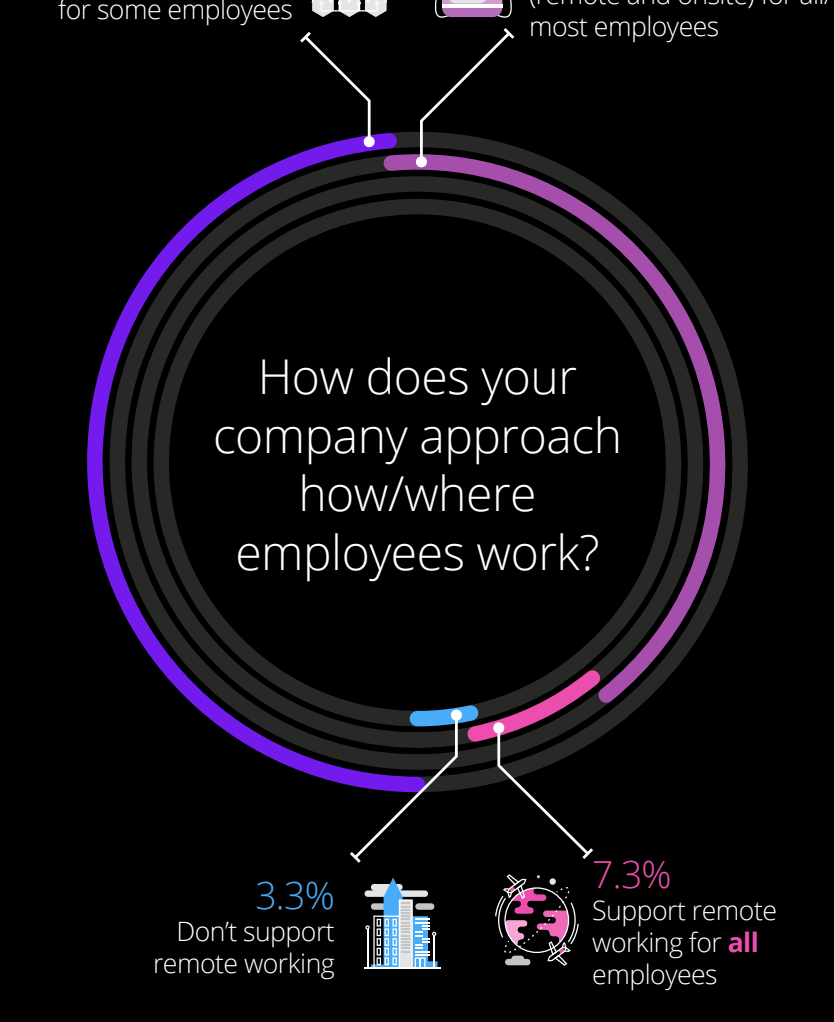


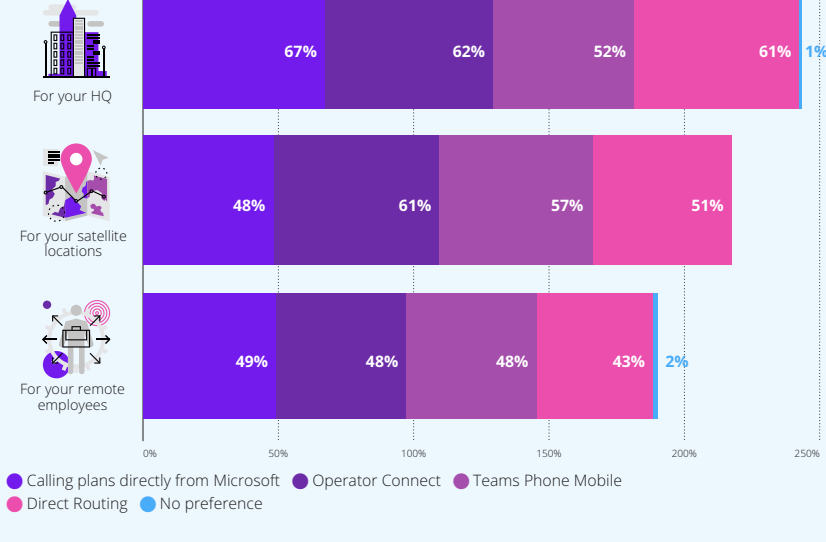
# There's no "one size fits (c)all" for Microsoft Teams

**97%\*** of organizations need to support remote employees in some capacity. Businesses need to consider a vendor with a heritage in mobile communications.



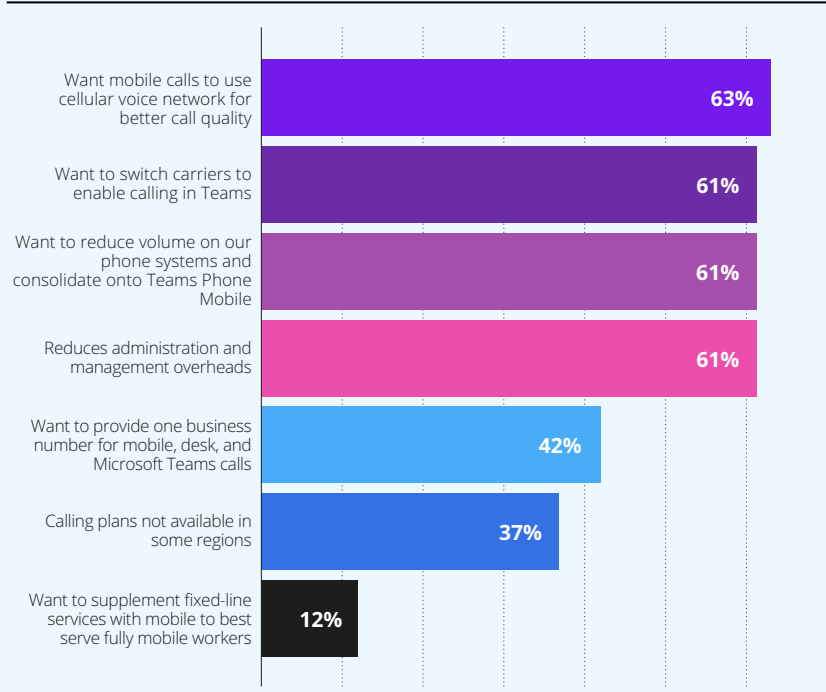
**48%** of companies prefer Teams Phone Mobile (formerly Operator Connect Mobile) for remote employees

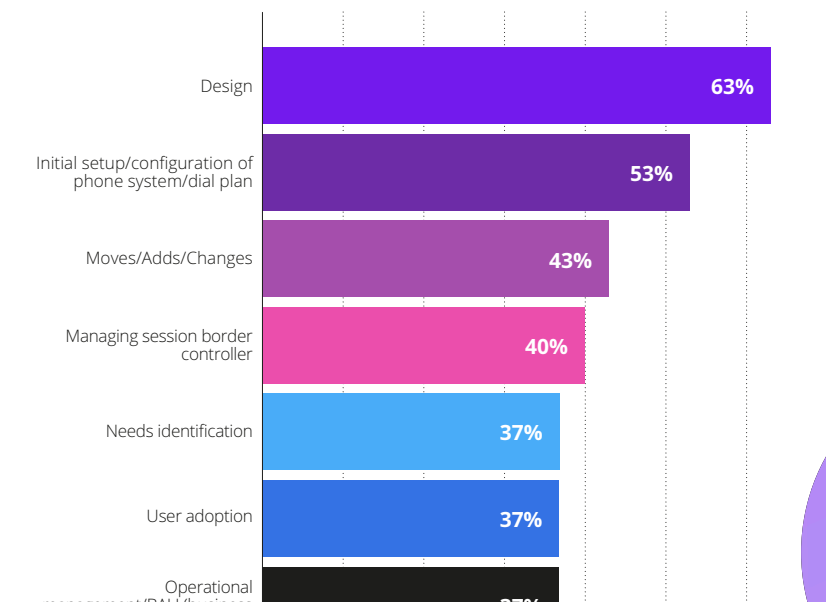
## Why do you prefer Teams Phone Mobile for PSTN connectivity?
