

## Special Construction Credit Promotion

Subject to the conditions below, Customers who order Verizon Access Optimized Services or Wavelength Services Solutions with a three year or higher Service Commitment, where Verizon has determined that a third-party vendor must perform special construction services, will receive a credit toward the special construction non-recurring charge (“NRC”) based on the Service Commitment Term as shown below. The credit will be applied in the month such NRC is invoiced.

### **Conditions and Exclusions.**

1. Only Local Access ports in the United States locations with wholly owned Verizon facilities are eligible for this Promotion. Not all Access circuits are eligible for this promotion. Eligible circuits will be specified in the Contract provided to Customer.
2. The following Access types are eligible:
  - a. Local Access with Switched Ethernet.
  - b. Wavelength Services Solution with Ethernet over TDM or DWDM.
  - c. Wavelength Services with DWDM.
- 3) Special construction associated with Access with TDM, Broadband, or Broadband Wireless handoff technology are not eligible for this Promotion.
- 4) The Promotional credit will never exceed the special construction charge per Customer site location.
- 5) If the Access or Wavelength Services are disconnected during the term of the Agreement, the amount of promotional credit applied to the NRC(s) may be charged back to Customer’s invoice.
